The Foothills are also ideal for bird and wildlife watching and photography. Wildflowers bloom throughout the area in the spring and early summer.

Visit the Foothills Learning Center to tour the Native Plant Garden, take a walk on the self-guided trail, or enjoy a meal in the picnic area. Hulls Gulch Reserve has trails suitable for hiking, mountain biking, horseback riding, and dog walking.

Table Rock is the most famous hiking destination in the Foothills. It stands 900 feet above downtown Boise and offers great views from the top. Table Rock is reached by a somewhat challenging 3.7-mile loop trail that takes about 2 ½ hours to hike.
