In the average house, 30% of winter heat loss happens through conventional windows and doors. Low-E glass can reduce heat loss by up to 50%. It also reduces heat gain from the

sun's infrared rays in warmer months. As a result, the glass helps homeowners save on utility bills.

Because it reduces the need for heating and cooling, low-E glass can reduce your home's carbon footprint and have a smaller environmental impact than a house with traditional clear glass windows.

Also, since the sun's UV and infrared rays are reflected away, upholstered furniture, artwork, carpet, and other materials won't fade as fast as they would near normal windows. The NFRC sticker on the window will tell you how much natural light comes through the glass.
